

Airside Parking

RAMP STICKER REQUIRED FOR VEHICLE RAMP ACCESS

Airside Operations Permit (Red)

This pass authorizes site entry through Lakeland Airside Center to conduct operations through GATE #31. When the vehicle is not in use it should be parked in the auto parking area south of the Warbird Ramp. **YOU ARE NOT PERMITTED TO DRIVE NORTH OF THE AIRSHOW LINE.**

Airside Parking Permit (Lime)

This pass authorizes entry through Lakeland Airside Center with access permitted through GATE #31. Proceed through Paradise City/Light Plane to Vintage Way to Airside Parking Only. Parking area is south of the Warbird Ramp.

Warbird Parking Permit (Lime/White Stripe)

This pass authorizes entry through Lakeland Airside Center with access permitted through GATE #31. The Warbird Parking area is located east of Taxiway Bravo and is accessed via ECHO 1.

All Site Driving and Parking

All Gates Access Pass (Purple)

This driving and parking pass allows transport through most access points onsite. **Access in NOT permitted in the core area between the hours of 9:00AM and 5:00PM, unless the vehicle pass has been issued a core access sticker.** If your assigned task does not require your vehicle, please park in a non-tow zone and proceed on foot. Auto parking is very limited within the convention site. Please park your vehicle in permitted areas only. Please make use of the Yellow Lot or the lot in front of the museum whenever possible.

Parking – Convention & Volunteers

Convention Auto Parking Permit (Orange)

Guest and Volunteer Parking. This parking pass allows parking in the main convention parking lot ONLY – free of charge. This pass can be used much like the Yellow Lot Pass for volunteer parking. No parking anywhere else on site.

Yellow Lot Parking Permit (Yellow)

Volunteer Parking Area – This parking pass permits the volunteer entry through Lakeland Airside Center. Follow signage to yellow lot parking. This pass also allows for parking in the Convention Lot (Orange Lot) if the Yellow Lot is full.

Convention Site Parking Permit (White with Blue Lettering)

This pass authorizes access through Lakeland Airside Center with convention site access via GATE #31. Parking is permitted in indicated area only, i.e. Work Area. Person who issues this pass is responsible for indicating **exactly** where the recipient is to park and on what days. This is issued on a limited basis based on situation.

Exhibitor/Media Parking Lot

Located west of Medulla Road (42 Acres)

Exhibitor Parking Permit (Pink)

This pass allows for the person in possession of this pass to park in the M/E lot. In addition, exhibitors have access to the exhibitor areas via GATE #125 (Rocky Road) **prior** to 9:00AM and **after** 5:00 PM during the week of the event, core sticker not required with this pass.

Food Service Parking Permit (Pink)

This parking pass allows for the person in possession of the pass to park in the M/E Lot.

Youth Tours Parking Permit (Pink)

This parking pass allows for the person in possession of the pass to park in the M/E Lot. This pass allows the guest to drop off and pick up ONLY students and/or children at the Piedmont Hangar via GATE #125 just inside the Rocky Road Gate.

Media Parking Permit (White with Red Lettering)

This parking pass allows for the person in possession of this pass to park in the M/E Lot. No convention site or core exhibit area access.

Special Parking and Access Permits

Reserved Parking Permit (Green)

This parking pass allows for sponsors/donors to park in the Reserved Parking Lot. This lot is limited to twenty (20) spaces and is located just west of Rocky Road, just inside GATE #125. This pass does not permit driving onto the convention ground or access to the core area.

Service & Delivery (Green)

This is **NOT** a parking pass. This pass allows for a service/delivery vehicle to access a desired location. Vehicle may enter site through GATE #31 via Lakeland Airside Center and then proceed to service or delivery area. Services are provided and then the entity leaves the convention site: example uses: Catering Vans, Ice Trucks, Handi-Can pump trucks.

This pass does not allow for event parking. If parking is required, then they will need to be issued a parking permit for one of the convention parking lots.

- A CORE Sticker is required to drive in the Core Area
- A RAMP Sicker is required to drive on the Warbird Ramp.

Campground Parking Pass (White with Purple Lettering)

This parking pass is for an assigned camp site and permits the holder to park an additional vehicle within the 20ft X 40ft campsite. The vehicle must be fully within the campsite; not on any roadway or thoroughfare. Entry to site may be either through Rocky Road GATE #125 or camper registration gates. Vehicle access is to campground only.

Golf Carts and Scooters

RAMP STICKER REQUIRED FOR GOLF CART OR SCOOTER RAMP ACCESS

Authorization Sticker (Year Specific)

This is issued to personal and rental golf carts and scooters. This sticker permits access to the convention site with the **exception** of the core area. Golf carts and scooters may use the golf cart paths to traverse the core area when necessary.

Authorization Core Sticker (Year Specific)

This is issued to personal and rental golf carts and scooters that need access to the Core Area during the day.

- Chairmen of the Area is responsible for requesting the appropriate sticker. Please limit requests for core access to golf carts and scooters that work in the core area during the show or need core access to fulfill duties necessary for your areas functioning.
