Lt Col Willie Allen- USAF JROTC National HQ ~ Flight Academy Director

Lt Col Willie J. Allen II is the Director of Flight Academy, HQ Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Corps (AFJROTC). The Flight Academy task is to expose and motivate 120,000+ AFJROTC cadets to the wonders of aviation as well as initiate diversity.

Lt Col Allen graduated from Fayetteville State University in 2000 and received his commission the same year through the Air Force ROTC program. He completed Joint Specialized Undergraduate Navigator Training (JSUNT) at Randolph AFB in 2001 and later Joint Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training (JSUPT) at Columbus AFB and NAS Corpus Christi in 2004-2005. During his career, Lt Col Allen has been qualified and deployed in three different airframes, RC-135S, RC-135U, and PC-12/U-28A. His leadership positions include 3xAssistant Operations Officer, Chief of Wing Airspace, Chief of Installation Exercise Program and Wing Inspection Team, 2xFlight Commander, and Air Operations Officer. Lt Col Allen has participated in numerous JCS directed Sensitive Reconnaissance Operations (SRO) and flown over 250 combat missions amassing nearly 1300 combat hours in support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM and Operation ENDURING FREEDOM as well as a staff officer supporting OPERATION INHERENT RESOLVE. In her position at CAP, Ms Mallett works across the country to coordinate free CAP airplane orientation flights and aerospace/STEM workshops for educators, and, with schools, museums, and youth organizations to connect K-12 youth with STEM-related products and programs, role models, and career opportunities. During the last 33 years, as an educator member of CAP, Ms Mallett has coordinated airplane flights for over 1,500 educators and 1,000 students, introducing them to the wonders of the sky and beyond.
